



LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

HR 1876 – Keeping Our Field Offices Open Act

Sponsor: John Larson (CT-1)

This bill prevents the closure of Social Security field and hearing offices and resident stations.

HR 1877 – Protecting Americans' Social Security Data Act

Sponsor: John Larson (CT-1)

This bill bars political appointees and special government employees from accessing the SSA database containing personally identifiable information about Social Security number holders and creates a right of civil action by an individual whose privacy was breached by a political appointee or a special government employee.

HR 4734 – Hands Off Social Security Act

Sponsor: Melanie Stansbury (NM-1)

This bill would protect Social Security benefits by preventing actions that could undermine the program's integrity, accessibility, security, and daily operations.

HR 7228 – Maintain Access to Vital Social Security Services Act

Sponsor: Gwen Moore (WI-4)

This bill amends title VII of the Social Security Act to establish minimum staffing levels and procedures when trying to close, consolidate, limit access to, or reduce services at field offices.

HR 8190 – Social Security Customer Service Act

Sponsor: Hayley Stevens (MI-11)

This bill would require the Social Security Administration to maintain a minimum number of full-time employees. Employees hired to fulfill the minimum must be placed in frontline positions.

S 2763 – Keep Billionaires Out of Social Security

Sponsor: Bernie Sanders (VT)

This bill prohibits the closure or reduced access to SSA field offices, hearings offices, resident stations or rural contact stations. It reestablishes the Office of Civil Rights and Equal Opportunity, the Transformation Office and Analytics, and Review and Oversight Office. This bill requires SSA administrative expenses to be at the level of 1.2% of benefits paid and puts SSA's administrative expenses off budget and not subject to yearly appropriations. It also restores the policy that no more than 10% of a Social Security check will be withheld to recoup an overpayment.

S 4214 – Artificial Intelligence Data Center Moratorium Act

Sponsor: Bernie Sanders (VT)

This bill would impose a moratorium on the construction or upgrade of all new artificial intelligence projects until Congress passes comprehensive AI legislation that ensure the safety and prosperity of the American public.

HR 1700 and S 770 – The Social Security Expansion Act

**Sponsors: Valerie Hoyle (OR-4)
Bernie Sanders (VT)**

This bill increases Social Security benefits, expands payroll taxes, and consolidates trust funds to ensure the long-term solvency of the Social Security program.

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
