The following is the email that will be sent to the US Senate Committee on Homeland Security and Government Affairs.

Subject line: Act Now and Confirm Ernest DuBester to the Federal Labor Relations Authority

To the members of the Senate Committee on Homeland Security and Government Affairs:

As a federal public servant and supporter, I write with a pressing request: confirm Ernest DuBester as President Biden's nominee to the Federal Labor Relations Authority before the end of this year.

Chairman DuBester is an exceptionally well-qualified candidate who has served as an FLRA member since 2009, including two terms as chair.

He brings a wealth of knowledge and experience in federal labor law, with a well-earned reputation for fairness and respect for the law -- as reflected in his nominations to the FLRA by four presidents from both political parties and Senate confirmation, with bipartisan support, six previous times.

It has now been more than a year since the President nominated Mr. DuBester to the FLRA. If no action is taken by the end of this month, his appointment will expire, resulting in a split, two-person board that will be unable to function effectively for the foreseeable future.

Federal public servants depend on a fully functioning and fair FLRA to ensure the stability of labor-management relations, to protect our ability to form and join unions, to bargain with agencies on working conditions, to resolve unfair labor practice complaints, and to know that our rights as workers will be protected so we can focus on serving the public.

The potential of a split board is bad news for federal employee unions that have only just begun to recover after five years of a Trump-majority at the FLRA. A committee delay of this nomination until 2023 will needlessly forestall a decision that is already overdue.

We ask that you and your colleagues on the Committee do your part by filing a discharge petition to bring Mr. DuBester's nomination out of committee and to the Senate floor for a confirmation vote.

Federal workers are on the brink of a serious setback—an avoidable one. As a member of the Senate Committee on Homeland Security and Government Affairs, you must protect federal workers and their families by confirming DuBester before the year is up.

His confirmation will help to ensure a fully functioning and fair FLRA and set an example for the rest of the country as to what fair and effective labor-management relationships can look like.
